Camp Groups

Groups I: ages 6 – 9

Skaters needing more practice on the “basics”—backwards skating, stops, cross-overs, stick handling, ball control, etc. Group I will have 2 hours of ice time each day plus a tournament game on Friday.

Groups II and III: ages 9 – 15

Skaters who have a good command of the basics, will do a lot of drilling on these skills working on speed, consistency, positioning, strategy, etc. Groups II and III will be divided according to ability, age and size, each group will have 2 hours of ice time each day plus a tournament game on Friday.

High School “mini camp”: ages 15 -17

Skaters interested in playing on the USA national U-17 team. This group is by invitation—for further information contact Chris Middlebrook or Nancy Nelson.



Camp Schedule

Camp will be in session Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. daily schedule will vary—you will receive a daily schedule with your confirmation of payment and group assignment. Each day will include on ice training, dryland training, time for fun and fitness, classroom time for language (Swedish) instruction. Friday schedule will include an afternoon “mini tournament”

Camp Checklist

On Ice Equipment: Skates, bandy sticks, helmet with mouth guard, shin pads, elbow pads, protective cup, sweat pants.

Off Ice Equipment: (for dryland and fun & fitness): Tennis shoes, shorts, sweat pants, socks, IT-shirts (extra socks and t-shirts recommended).

Food: Each camper must bring their own lunch and morning/afternoon snacks. Vending machines and drinking fountains are available.

Insurance: Every camper's parents or guardians are required to have primary medical and dental insurance which covers their child's activities in the American International Bandy Camp.
